NATO'S RUTTE BACKS BOSNIA AFTER SEPARATIST MOVES BY SERBIAN REGION

NATO Secretary-General Mark Rutte has pledged the military alliances unwavering support for Bosnia and Herzegovinas federal government after a series of separatist moves from Bosnian Serb leaders.

Rutte spoke in Sarajevo on Monday after meeting the three members of Bosnias multiethnic presidency shortly after Bosnian Serb lawmakers passed legislation barring federal judicial authorities and police from operating in the autonomous territory of Republika Srpska.

The NATO chief said any actions that undermine the Dayton Agreement, which ended the countrys 1992-1995 war, were unacceptable. He warned that inflammatory rhetoric and actions posed a direct threat to Bosnias stability and security.
