KAZAKHSTAN-GEORGIA ENERGY DEAL POISED TO BOOST MIDDLE CORRIDOR CONNECTIVITY

Kazakhstan and Georgia are set to deepen energy cooperation with a strong focus on boosting connectivity along the Trans-Caspian International Transport Route (Middle Corridor), Trend reports via Kazakhstan's government.

This intention was confirmed at a meeting in Astana between Kazakhstan's Minister of Energy Yerlan Akkenzhenov and Georgian Minister of Economy and Sustainable Development Mariam Kvrivishvili, held as part of the visit of the Georgian delegation.

Akkenzhenov congratulated Kvrivishvili on her recent appointment and expressed confidence that economic ties between the two countries will be revitalized under her leadership.
