
TURKMENISTAN ADVOCATES STRENGTHENING GLOBAL PARTNERSHIPS AT LLDC3 CONFERENCE

President of Turkmenistan Serdar Berdimuhamedov voiced a set of proposals aimed at strengthening international cooperation for sustainable development during the opening ceremony of the Third UN Conference on Landlocked Developing Countries (LLDC3), held in the Awaza National Tourist Zone, Trend reports.

In his address, Berdimuhamedov emphasized the significance of the forum in advancing the implementation of key United Nations frameworks, including the 2030 Sustainable Development Agenda and the Pact for the Future. He called for an integrated approach to addressing the humanitarian, economic, social, and environmental challenges faced by landlocked nations.

Berdimuhamedov underlined Turkmenistans domestic focus on social protection, healthcare, and human development, while also pointing to the structural difficulties landlocked countries face due to restricted access to international transport corridors. These constraints, he noted, undermine the delivery of humanitarian and medical aid and weaken social infrastructure.
