CENTRAL ASIAN NATIONS GEAR UP TO PUSH FORWARD REGIONAL CLIMATE AGENDA AHEAD OF COP30

A regional dialogue of Central Asian countries in preparation for the 30th Conference of the Parties to the UN Framework Convention on Climate Change (COP30) was held in Dushanbe, Trend reports via the Committee for Environmental Protection under the Government of Tajikistan.

Held under the slogan 80 Million People, 5 Countries, 1 Voice, the event brought together senior government officials, representatives of international organizations, and climate experts to develop a unified regional position ahead of the global climate summit.

In his address, Isfandiyor Shukurzoda, First Deputy Chairman of Tajikistans Committee for Environmental Protection, emphasized that only through close regional cooperation can Central Asian countries effectively respond to transboundary challenges such as glacier melt and attract financing for green growth.
