
RUSSIA DISMISSES EU AID PACKAGE FOR ARMENIA AS INEFFECTIVE

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Russian Deputy Prime Minister Alexei Overchuk has dismissed the significance of a planned European Union financial support package for Armenia, saying it would have no meaningful economic impact.

Speaking to Interfax, Overchuk said the proposed assistance of around 100 million would be insufficient.

This solves absolutely nothing. These are not the right figures. Our trade volumes (with Armenia included.) are completely different; I don't even want to comment on this, he said.

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
