
MIRZIYOYEV SAYS UZBEKISTAN'S DOORS WILL 'ALWAYS REMAIN OPEN' AS FIFTH TASHKENT INVESTMENT FORUM BEGINS

President Shavkat Mirziyoyev opened the Fifth Tashkent International Investment Forum (TIIF) on Wednesday with a message aimed squarely at the nearly 4,000 mostly foreign delegates packed into the hall: Uzbekistans doors are open, and the country intends to keep them that way.

Speaking under this years theme, Investment Resilience: New Frontiers, New Partnerships, Mirziyoyev framed the forum as more than a transactional venue for capital, but as a platform to initiate and deepen long-term mutually beneficial partnerships. He described what he called the Tashkent investment spirit □ a phrase he used to capture the events evolution into what he called a symbol of shared success between Uzbekistan and the partners willing to back it. The sentiment ran through his closing remarks, where he told the room that the most important partner in turning ambitious plans into reality is an investor who arrives with good intentions. Therefore, the doors of New Uzbekistan will always remain open to foreign investors who come to our country with trust and ideas.
