President Kassym-Jomart Tokayev held talks with European Council President António Costa and European Commission President Ursula von der Leyen on June 23, focusing on strengthening Kazakhstan-EU strategic partnership in trade, investment, transport connectivity, and energy cooperation.

The meeting covered key areas including critical raw materials, transport and logistics, digital transformation, energy cooperation, and climate policy. The officials also reviewed prospects for expanding cooperation under the Enhanced Partnership and Cooperation Agreement (EPCA) and the EUs Global Gateway strategy.

Tokayev emphasized Kazakhstan's role as a reliable partner to the European Union and underlined the importance of maintaining strong political dialogue and expanding economic engagement, Akorda reported.
