**EU REVIEWS KOSOVO REFORMS BUT WARNS DELAYS RISK OVERSHADOWING PROGRESS**

*Kosovo and the European Union held their seventh Stabilisation and Association Committee meeting in Pristina on Tuesday to review political developments and progress on reforms linked to Kosovos EU-related commitments.*

The meeting was opened by Kosovos Chief Negotiator with the EU, Jeton Zulfaj, and Valentina Superti, Director for the Western Balkans (\*) in the European Commissions Directorate-General for Enlargement and Eastern Neighbourhood (DG ENEST), the European External Action Service (EEAS) announced.

It was co-chaired by Arben Krasniqi, General Secretary at Kosovos Office of the Prime Minister, and Jiri Plecity, head of the DG ENEST unit responsible for Kosovo.
